

Some Last Minute Details

DEPARTURES/ARRIVALS: **On all arrival or departure days, please drop off or pick up your child or children after 0900hrs and before 1130hrs.** Parents who have children either **leaving July 07th** or **arriving July 08th**, please note that **we do not offer transportation for those dates unless an airport pick up is necessary.** You must make your own travel arrangements.

Departure day: **If your child is not being picked up by his/her parents then you must notify the camp who will be picking them up via phone, e-mail, fax or letter.**

BUS SCHEDULE: Transport **to Wilvaken** will run on **Thursday June 24th, and Friday July 23rd, and August 06th.** Departure is at 0900hrs from Côte St. Luc shopping centre, 0945hrs from Place Portobello on the south shore.

Transport **to Montreal** will run on **Wednesday July 21st and Thursday August 05th and 19th.** Departure from Wilvaken will be about **10:30hrs**, to arrive at Place Portobello at 12:00hrs (noon), and Côte St. Luc about 1245hrs.

Please check the general information sheet for bus stop descriptions.

TRANSPORT EXPENSES:(taxes included) Chartered bus - one way \$45.15 and round trip \$81.27

To be paid with invoice.

Airport trip - one way \$95.94 and round trip \$169.31

ILLNESS: We would like to advise parents that should your child not be feeling well the day before camp starts to keep him/her home for an extra day and notify us by phone. Also, if your child has been in contact within the two weeks prior to camp with anyone who has had a contagious illness such as Chicken pox and has not had it her/himself, to notify the nurse upon arrival at camp.

PHONE CALLS: AS A REMINDER, PLEASE NOTE that calls to your children are disruptive and may upset them especially if there is a chance of homesickness. PLEASE ask to speak to the counsellor or director if you have concerns. Do not expect a return call from your child if you have left a message unless it is urgent.

Write letters to your children! They love to receive them!

DIRECTIONS: From Montréal, take the Eastern Townships Autoroute (route 10) to exit 118 (**Orford - Magog**).

Follow 141 South into Magog. This road becomes Merry St. in Magog. Continue straight on Merry St. through two sets of traffic lights, down the hill, across the tracks and over the bridge towards McDonald's.

At McDonald's turn **left** (still on 141 South) towards **Ayer's Cliff**. Continue on 141 for six (6) km. to the flashing yellow light at the T-junction with the **Fitch Bay** road.

Turn **right** onto the Fitch Bay road. Follow this road for just over three km. (3.3 km. approximately).

Turn **right** onto the private road to Wilvaken. **Please drive slowly on the Wilvaken road at ALL times!**

From Trois-Rivières or Québec City, take Autoroute 55 from Drummondville. This joins Autoroute 10 near Magog. Follow Autoroute 10, direction **Montréal** to exit 118. From this exit, follow the route as described above.

From New England, take I-91 north through Vermont. This becomes Autoroute 55 at the Québec border. Continue on 55 to exit 21 (**Ayer's Cliff - Coaticook**). At the exit turn **left** on 141 north towards **Magog**. Follow 141 for about 3.5 miles (6 km.) to the flashing yellow light at the T-junction with the **Fitch Bay** road.

Turn **left** onto the Fitch Bay road. Follow this road for just over 2 miles (3.3 km. approximately).

Turn **right** onto the private road to Wilvaken. **Please drive slowly on the Wilvaken road at ALL times!**

VISITING DAYS: **Our normal visiting days are Sundays: July 04^h and 18th, August 1st and 15th.** Visits begin at 10:00 am. since Sunday morning is a sleep-in for the camp. You may bring a picnic lunch and enjoy the Wilvaken site and beach, or you may take your child out for the afternoon. Please inform the staff member at the lodge before taking a camper off the site, and when returning. If you wish to take out a non-family member (relative, or child of friends) we ask that you bring written permission from the parents. We regret that space limitations do not permit us to invite parents to join us in the lodge for meals. Please return your child to camp by 5:00 PM so he/she can join in the evening program.

NB - for children coming from afar or not having parental visitation, you may send a note with your child or via e-mail/fax giving your permission to allow the directors of the camp to "OK" (at their discretion) excursions with families of your child's friend on visiting days.

If for some reason the normal visiting dates are not convenient, please feel free to call us and make other arrangements.

For children involved in riding there will be a show on Sunday July 18th, which usually begins at 10:00, so try to be there. There may be a riding show on some of the other visiting days. We also try to have a water-ski show on some of the visiting days, so ask your child about it when you come to visit and stay to watch the performance.

CLOTHES: Campers will have the opportunity to purchase t-shirts (\$8+tx), hats (\$10+tx) and kangaroo sweatshirts(\$27+tx) as well as refillable Nalgene style water bottles (\$10+tx) at the camp store during their stay. This will be charged to the campers deposit on personal extras.

CAMP PHOTO: As we have done for the past 18 years, we will be offering to campers the opportunity to order a professionally prepared 50cm x 20cm (20" x 8") camp photo. This makes a great souvenir, with all the staff and campers for the session included. The photo will be taken by Howard Kay and will be printed and available before departure at the end of each session. The cost will be \$16 + tax, which will be charged to the campers deposit on personal extras.
